Energy Costs are Rising

As we look at what's coming in 2026, it's clear that wholesale energy costs from our power providers will be higher. Like you, South Central Electric gets monthly electric bills from our power suppliers based on our monthly purchases. The amount South Central Electric is billed depends on how much energy the cooperative (that's all our members) used and when it was used. These costs are directly passed on to members on their monthly bills.

We also purchase the excess energy from our members with wind or solar generation. Net metering rules in Minnesota require us to purchase power from these systems (under 40kW capacity) at the average retail rate for that rate class. These rules put added pressure on rates. In 2024, we purchased over 1,300,000 kWhs of excess member generation at higher costs than from our power suppliers.

What can members expect in 2026? We see wholesale power costs increasing by approximately 10% in 2026. These costs are passed directly onto members through the wholesale energy rates on your monthly bill. It's the amount South Central Electric was billed for the energy members used.

It is important to note that your cooperative does everything it can to mitigate wholesale power purchases through load management programs like the peak shave water heater program and other programs. We are constantly monitoring our system and implementing demand response programs to help lower your bills.

As we move into 2026, South Central Electric remains committed to transparency and efficiency. While rising wholesale energy costs are a challenge, we continue working hard to manage expenses and explore innovative solutions to keep your energy bills as low as possible. By participating in load management programs and staying informed, members can play a vital role in helping us reduce wholesale power costs.

What to do when you lose power

Power outages can strike without warning, whether caused by severe weather, equipment failure or scheduled maintenance. In those first few moments, knowing what to do can help you stay safe and avoid unnecessary stress.

Before calling South Central Electric, the very first thing you should do is check your breaker box. A tripped breaker is one of the most common reasons for losing power in just part of your home or apartment.

To check, open the panel door and look for any switches that are out of alignment — either fully off or stuck between on and off. Flip the switch completely off, then back on. This simple reset can often restore power immediately.

In single-family homes, breaker boxes are usually in the basement, garage or utility room, or sometimes mounted on an exterior wall. If you're unsure where yours is, your building manager or maintenance team can help you locate it.

If your breaker box looks fine and power is still out, it's time to check with your neighbors to see if they're affected. If they are, report the outage to South Central Electric. While waiting for updates, unplug sensitive electronics to protect them from power surges when electricity returns. Use flashlights instead of candles to reduce fire risk. Keep refrigerator and freezer doors closed to preserve food.

Being prepared for outages is just as important as knowing what to do when they happen. Keep a flashlight, extra batteries and a portable phone charger in an easy-to-reach spot. A battery-powered radio can help you stay informed during extended outages, and having your electric cooperative's contact information or app handy will make reporting issues faster and easier.
